CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English

In English this term, we will be continuing to use The Power Of Reading approach, immersing the children in our key texts. This enables us to mimic a significant author.

Reading

New destination reader! The approach involves daily sessions incorporating whole class modelling prior to the children applying these skills through partner work and independent reading. Children will deepen their understanding of the texts they read through the systematic use of a series of strategies and language stems.

Computing

In computing we will be recognising common uses of information technology beyond school.

Science

In Science, we will be describing how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending twisting and stretching.

Geography

In Geography we will be focusing on key human and physical features of the local area.
