


The world would be more awesome if ...

It's not just things you love.


You can be passionate about solving a problem. We all have things in ours lives that we'd like to see be different.

#29 Talk gooder




Bonus ideas?

The average person says around 16,000 words in a day. That's a lot of chances to make the world more awesome.


What could you add to the list?

The world is changed in little pieces every single day. It's all about the little things we do daily that add up to something really big.


